Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The Department recommends that Call Gravel maintain a copy of this letter, the June 5, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operation.
