On February 24, 2004, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Continental Custom Crushing & Asphalt for a portable rock-crushing facility. A supplementary registration was submitted March 1, 2004 to correct and verify the equipment serial numbers provided February 24th. The information provided below is a complete and current listing of information registered by Continental Custom Crushing & Asphalt. The information registered is required by IDAPA 58.01.01.797.02 *Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*.

Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The DEQ recommends that Continental Custom Crushing & Asphalt maintain this letter, the March 1, 2004 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operations.

Please be aware that Continental Custom Crushing & Asphalt is required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant, or any registered equipment, is moved to a new site of operations.
