On June 5, 2003 the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Kiewit Pacific Co for a nonmetallic mineral processing plant. There is no existing air quality permit associated with this company; therefore, no termination action is required.

Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The Department recommends Kiewit Pacific Co maintain this letter, the June 4, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operation.
