

LEGAL NOTICE OF FILING OF
PETITION FOR CONTESTED CASE
BEFORE THE BOARD OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

On March 17, 2009, Sierra Club, Idaho Conservation League, and Shoshone-Bannock Tribes (Petitioners) filed a Petition for Contested Case Proceeding with the Board of Environmental Quality (Board). The Petitioners are seeking Board review of Air Quality Permit to Construct No. P-2008.0066 issued by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on February 10, 2009 to Southeast Idaho Energy, LLC (SIE) for construction of the Power County Advanced Energy Center near American Falls. On March 18, 2009, the Petitioners, DEQ and SIE entered into a Stipulation to Stay Proceedings Pending Negotiations.

The Rules of Administrative Procedure Before the Board of Environmental Quality, IDAPA 58.01.23, allow persons who claim a direct and substantial interest in the proceeding to file a petition with the Board for an order granting intervention to become a party. **Pursuant to IDAPA 58.01.23.352.01, petitions to intervene must be filed with the Hearing Coordinator within fourteen (14) days of the publication date of this notice.**
