A PERMIT APPLICATION AND PROPOSED PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT**

In compliance with Section 58.01.01.209, Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho, notice is hereby given that McCain Foods, Burley, has applied to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a permit to construct, P-2012.0043 Project 61312, to reconfigure Prime 2 dryer and fryer lines for efficiency purposes, and to increase the annual amount of natural gas used at the facility. The facility, a French fries food processing facility, is located at 218 West Highway 30, Burley.
