Dear Mr. Shepherd:

During the facility inspection on April 30, 2014, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) personnel observed that the house where Monitoring Well GW-037-12 is located is vacant and has been for some time. As a result, power is not available at the well, which yields the well inoperable for ground water sampling. In addition, the land application field adjacent to this domestic well, MU-037-09 (Field 3-West Section), is not being used for land application, and there are no plans to do so in the near future.

DEQ has determined it is appropriate to monitor an active well adjacent to an active land application site. Therefore, effective with this modification, Well GW-037-12 now designates the domestic well located west of Pivot 1 and north of GW-037-13.

Table 5.2.1 of the Reuse Permit M-037-04 shall be replaced with the following:



GW-037-03	MW-3 Well located north of Hamilton Road, south of Lagoon Cell 9	Monitoring well	Side-gradient of the land application site (shallow aquifer)
GW-037-06	MW-6 Well located at the northwest corner of Field 1	Monitoring well	Side-gradient of the land application site (intermediate/shallow aquifer)
GW-037-07	MW-7 Well located at the northeast corner of Field 1	Monitoring well	Side-gradient of the land application site (intermediate/shallow aquifer)
GW-037-12	Well west of Pivot 1	Domestic well ^a	Down gradient of the land application site (regional aquifer)
GW-037-13	Well west of Field 4	Domestic well ^a	Down gradient of the land application site (regional aquifer)
