Subject: Outlet Bay Sewer District, Reuse Permit LA-000018-04, Minor Permit  
Modification

Dear Mr. Hoagland:

This letter is a notification regarding a modification to the Outlet Bay Sewer District Reuse Permit LA-000018-04 issued by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on May 1, 2010. Your permit is currently scheduled to expire on May 1, 2015. This modification, referred to as Modification 1, extends the permit expiration date by one (1) year. With the issuance of this modification, Outlet Bay Sewer District is permitted to continue operating the wastewater reuse system under the terms and conditions of the current permit until May 1, 2016.

Per IDAPA 58.01.17.700, a modification may be initiated by DEQ in the event of a change to standards or regulations after the permit was issued. In 2011, IDAPA 58.01.17 (Recycled Water Rules) was changed to allow DEQ to issue permits for up to 10 years. Per the Recycled Water Rules, this modification is considered a minor modification; therefore, no public comment period is necessary.

Annual reports and monitoring data from the Outlet Bay Sewer District recycled water system demonstrate substantial compliance with Permit LA-000018-04. Permit LA-000018-04 allows the Outlet Bay Sewer District to irrigate up to 29.6 million gallons per year on 46 acres. Hydraulic loading has ranged between 13.1 and 16.3 million gallons through the duration of this permit. Permit LA-000018-04 also sets a maximum nitrogen loading limit of 143 lbs./acre-year; annual nitrogen loading has ranged from 26 to 49 lbs./acre-year. Allowing Outlet Bay Sewer District to continue operating the reuse facility in compliance with their permit for an additional year will not pose any increased risk to human health or the environment.

Please note that the dates of the compliance activities listed in the permit will not change with the exception of Compliance Activity CA-018-03 which will now correspond with the new permit expiration date. All monitoring and reporting requirements, including submittal to DEQ of an annual site performance report, remain unchanged by this permit modification.


**Complete Description of Modification**
