- Boise WaterShed Educational Center: Tour this LEED building with educational interactive exhibits and an overview of the public-private partnership and plans for Phase II.
- West Boise Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF): tour the facility and about their innovative Phosphorus projects
- Laboratories: State-of-the-art clean metals lab, Soils-Biosolids lab and wet chemistry lab
- Struvite Nutrient Recovery Facility: 1,270 dry tons/year Struvite recovery plant.

- Participants must wear closed toed shoes suitable for walking ½ to 1 mile.
