Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. DEQ recommends Kiewit Pacific Co. maintain this letter, the August 22, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operation.
