The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) Registration form on January 20, 2003 from Walters Ready-Mix, Inc.. On February 17, 2004 DEQ received the required registration fee. The registration is for the following equipment:

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Your registration for Permit by Rule is in our files. Please be advised that the registered equipment must comply with the Rules for the Control of Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.790 through 802 (*Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*). You will be required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant is moved to a new site of operations. DEQ requires that this form be submitted at least ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
