On August 7, 2003 the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Wood's Crushing and Hauling Inc to modify a nonmetallic mineral processing plant. On September 19, 2003 DEQ received Wood's Crushing and Hauling's Permit by Rule registration fee. 

This registration terminates PBR number P-020900 registered on March 22, 2002.

Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The DEQ recommends Wood's Crushing and Hauling Inc maintain this letter, the August 4, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operation. Please be aware that Wood's Crushing and Hauling Inc is required to submit a portable equipment relocation form to the Department at least ten days prior to relocating the plant to a new site of operations. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
