The purpose of this Statement of Basis is to set forth the legal and factual basis for the Tier I operating permit terms and conditions including references to the applicable statutory or regulatory provisions for the terms and conditions as required by IDAPA 58.01.01.362

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1. INTRODUCTION AND APPLICABILITY

Clearwater Paper Corporation, Consumer Products Division is a manufacturer of tissue products, and is located at Lewiston, Idaho. The facility is classified as a major facility, as defined by IDAPA 58.01.01.008.10.c and was issued a renewed Tier I operating permit on January 1, 2010.

This permit action is to administratively amend the Tier I permit to correct typographical errors. On January 28, 2010 Clearwater informed DEQ of a typographical error in Section 3.3 of the Tier I permit. The condition currently refers to the 2L tissue machine instead of the 1L tissue machine.

2. FACILITY INFORMATION

2.1 Facility Description

The facility description remains unchanged from the January 1, 2010 Statement of Basis that supported the issuance of T1-2007.0105 and is not repeated as part of this Statement of Basis.

The AIRs classification for the facility also remains unchanged.

2.2 Facility Permitting History

2.2.1 Tier I Operating Permit History – Previous 5-year permit term January 1, 2010 to January 1, 2015

The following information is the permitting history of this Tier I facility for the current five-year permit term which was is from January 1, 2010 to January 1, 2015. This information was derived from a review of the permit files available to DEQ. Permit status is noted as active and in effect (A) or superseded (S).

January 1, 2010 T1-2007.0105, Permit Renewal, Permit status (superseded by this permit)

2.2.2 Underlying Permit History – Includes every underlying permit issued to this facility

The underlying permit history remains unchanged. The permit history may be seen in the January 1, 2010 Statement of Basis that supported the issuance of T1-2007.0105.

3. APPLICATION SCOPE AND APPLICATION CHRONOLOGY

3.1 Application Scope

Clearwater did not submit a formal application for the administrative amendment. The administrative amendment was instigated by DEQ by letter on February 22, 2010 in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.381.

5.2 Changes to the Tier I Permit

Permit Condition 1.2 lists the underlying permits that are incorporated into the Tier I permit. This list currently includes Air Pollution Source Permit #1140-0001 issued August 22, 1984. This permit is listed as one of the underlying permits that are included in the Tier I permit though none of the permit conditions are actually included in the Tier I permit. This permit expired on its own merits on August 22, 1989 and it was a DEQ oversight to include it in this list. DEQ has amended the permit to remove this permit from the list.

Permit condition 3.3 currently refers to the 2L tissue machine instead of the 1L tissue machine. Permit Condition 3.3 has been amended to refer to the 1L Tissue Machine; no other changes were made to Permit Condition 3.3.

No other changes were made to the Tier I permit.

6. REGULATORY REVIEW

The regulatory basis for the Tier I permit remains unchanged from the January 1, 2010 Statement of Basis that supported the issuance of T1-2007.0105 and is not repeated as part of this Statement of Basis.

7. PUBLIC COMMENT

This Tier I permit change is being processed as an administrative amendment in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.381. The changes to the permit are to correct a typographical error and to remove mention of the Air Pollution Source Permit #1140-0001 issued August 22, 1984. Administrative amendment provisions allow such changes to be made without notice to the public or affected states. Therefore public notice was not provided.

8. EPA REVIEW OF PROPOSED PERMIT

In accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.381.02.c DEQ shall submit a copy of the revised final permit to EPA without the need for review.
