The Department of Environmental Quality is issuing the above-referenced Wastewater Reuse Permit Modification to the original Silverwood reuse permit made effective on June 6, 2008. The enclosed document, titled Appendix 3, is your official copy of the permit modification, which demonstrates that you are authorized to operate the Silverwood wastewater reuse facility subject to certain specific requirements. The permit modification includes the East Field with the West Field as Class C irrigation areas and allows Class C irrigation to start April 1 and end October 31.

No comments on the draft permit modification or staff analysis were received by DEQ to the public notice issued on March 25, 2010 for the proposed permit modifications.

Appendix 3 Modification to WASTEWATER REUSE PERMIT LA-000217-01 Silverwood Inc.

Permittee Name: Silverwood Inc.

Effective Date of Permit: June 6, 2008

Effective Date of this Modification: April 1, 2010

Complete Description of the Modifications:

- The Class C effluent requirement for “Application Site Areas and Timing” in Section F Permit Limits and Conditions on page 9 is modified as **bolded** below as follows to allow effluent irrigation on MU-0217-01 and new MU-0217-03 starting April 1 and ending October 31.

Treatment	Oxidized, coagulated, clarified, filtered, (or treated to an equivalent process) and disinfected.	Oxidized and disinfected
Application Site Areas and Timing See map in Appendix 3.	Primary Area - approximately 10 acres within the nursery/grass field near the treatment lagoons Boulder Beach - approximately 8 acres of designated landscaped areas at the theme park. Effluent may be irrigated each year between May 1 and September 30 th or as otherwise allowed in writing by DEQ prior to reuse. Boulder Beach area may be irrigated only during periods of non-use of the park by the public.	Primary Areas only – approximately 19 acres within the nursery/grass field near the treatment lagoons consisting of MU-0217-01 and MU-0217-03. Effluent may be irrigated each year between April 1 and October 31st or as otherwise allowed in writing by DEQ prior to reuse.

- The first table in Appendix 1 Environmental Monitoring Serial Numbers entitled Hydraulic Management Units shall be modified to add MU-0217-03 which is 9.1-acreas of additional Class C Primary Area 2
