
If you got six or more points, you are an environmental superstar! Keep up the good work and help your friends and family be your good example.

Who Is Protecting Idaho's Clean Air, Land, and Water?



To keep Idaho's air, land, and water clean, we need to protect them from pollution – things like litter and car exhaust. Everyone can help; let's learn how!



Hi! My name is Lindsay and I work at the Department of Environmental Quality, or "DEQ." My co-workers and I help businesses and people follow environmental laws and rules. DEQ is part of Idaho's state government. Its job is to keep Idaho's air, land, and water clean and protect people in Idaho from pollution, which can make us sick.

DEQ, businesses, adults, and kids are all responsible for protecting Idaho's environment, and each can do different things to help. For example, businesses have to get permits (kind of like permission slips) from DEQ to limit pollution from their factories and other activities. **Find the underlined words below that show who does what. 
