The DEQ will work with WAG participants to complete a Subbasin Assessment (SBA) and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) document for the Fish Creek Watershed, specifically for the pollutants and stream segments listed on the enclosed table. While this Fish Creek TMDL effort will address the state of Idaho portions of the Fish Creek watershed, it will be coordinated with TMDLs being developed for the Washington portions of the watershed. It is the intent of the department to have diverse representation from industries and interests affected by the management of the Fish Creek watershed. DEQ will be responsible for consulting with WAG participants on a regular basis throughout the development of the TMDL. (WAG members may choose to continue serving to develop an implementation plan. Initial commitment through the TMDL development is expected of those interested in participating as a WAG member.)

It is anticipated the 2-3 hour meetings will be held approximately monthly. A meeting place will be determined from WAG feedback and will try to incorporate the needs of all those interested.
