Dear Mr. Van Every:

On April 8, 2014, Twin Lakes Canal Company (TLCC) submitted an application for 401 Water Quality Certification for the Bear River Narrows Hydroelectric Project. In IDEQ's letter to me dated 3-Nov-2015 you recommended that TLCC withdraw its certification request so that IDEQ can obtain and consider additional information forthcoming from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's NEPA process, which is not yet complete.

Accordingly, TLCC hereby withdraws its request for 401 certification dated April 8, 2014. Concurrently, TLCC requests resubmittal of the same 401 certification application to the IDEQ. This resubmission request for 401 certification should provide the parties with adequate time to assess project effects on waters of the state of Idaho.
