

## Preliminary Project Overview of the WSV Woodstove Change out Program For CAC Information only


- All potential applicants will apply during an annual application period running during the winter months of each year. Income levels will be requested on the application based on the Federal Low income Guidelines. DEQ has determined that the low income threshold for this program is 200% of the current Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- All applicants will be prioritized based on where they live and income level via the following table:

**Table 1. Approval Priorities\***


- Project Coordinator, Dan Smith, will schedule a home inspection to confirm stove type and eligibility; home square footage; and chimney and hearth conditions. Part of this visit is to assess the applicants need for other portions of the grant (home weatherization, wood sheds, etc.).
- Upon application approval, the Applicant will contact the vendor of their choice from the Approved Vendor list to receive an estimate.
- The Vendor will then submit the estimate to DEQ for approval. DEQ will review the estimate to ensure it meets the program requirements.
- Vendor is responsible for installing the device, ensuring all required permits and inspections are completed, ensuring the old device is properly destroyed, and educating the homeowner on stove use.
- DEQ will pay the Vendor directly. The homeowner will not be required to pay the vendor as long as the estimate is approved by DEQ and meets all program requirements.
- DEQ will conduct 2 follow-up educational visits to the homeowner. The first within 2 months of installation and the second 12 months after the installation or before Sept. 30, 2020, whichever comes first.
