Same	Same	2	6.5	33	Corrective Actions	Corrective actions can be taken within the same day as discovery with subsequent actions within 14 days. Some corrective actions like a BMP replacement would likely take longer than 14 days. A statement should be inserted after the 14 days sentence: "If more than 14 days are necessary to conduct corrective action, the permittee must notify DEQ of their intention to exceed 14 days, the rationale for an extension, and the targeted completion date." The final sentence in the paragraph about maintaining a record of all corrective actions would apply as stated. The inserted language is similar to the EPA's 2015 MSGP, with simplifying modification.
