**PETITION INITIATING A  
CONTESTED CASE**

COMES NOW, Canyon County, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, and legal owner of the vehicles described in Attachment A, affixed hereto and incorporated by reference, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, and petitions the Idaho Board of Environmental Quality for a contested case proceeding pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 39-107(5), 39-116B(4), 67-5201, et. al., and IDAPA 58.01.23, Rules of Administrative Procedure Before the Board of Environmental Quality.

Petitioner seeks review of the decision of the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality/Board of Environmental Quality/Director of Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (collectively, the "Agency") that Petitioner's motor vehicle registration may be revoked by the Idaho Transportation Department.

In notice dated February 17, 2011, the Agency asserted that registration for the vehicles described in Attachment A will be revoked by the Idaho Transportation Department without further notice unless petitioner complies with the emission testing requirements putatively established by I.C. § 39-116B or files a petition for contested case within thirty-five (35) days of the date of notice.

Idaho Code § 39-116B(4) provides, among other things, that no vehicle shall be identified by Idaho Department of Environmental Quality to the Idaho Transportation Department as having failed to comply with the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program unless the Department certifies that the owner of the motor vehicle has been given notice and had the opportunity for a hearing concerning the program and exhausted all remedies and appeals from any determination made at such hearing.

Petitioner therefore hereby demands such hearing for the purpose of requesting that the Board of Environmental Quality enter an order that exempts the vehicles listed in Attachment A from emission testing requirements.

Petitioner also requests that the Board of Environmental Quality voluntarily enter, in the name of public policy and in a manner consistent with the social and economic foundations of Idaho law, a separate order that (1) affects the suspension of emission testing in Canyon County until such time as the deficiencies herein described have been remedied; and (2) directs the Agency to refund the monies expended by Canyon County residents in good faith compliance with Agency directives that threatened certification of said residents' failure to comply with the I.C. § 39-116B inspection and maintenance program; and (3) such other relief as the Presiding Officer(s) believe warranted.

The bases for these requests for relief are as follows:

- 1. The Agency has acted without a reasonable basis in law by enforcing compliance in Canyon County with statements that the Agency did not promulgate as rules under the Idaho Administrative Procedure Act's rulemaking provisions, in contravention of I.C. §§ 39-116B, 67-5220 through 67-5225 and 67-5227, and other applicable law.**

Idaho Code § 39-116B(2) authorized and mandated the Agency to establish by rule minimum standards for an inspection and maintenance program for registered motor vehicles, providing for, among other things, "Counties and cities within the airshed that will be subject to the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program." However, the Agency determined, before legislative approval had been granted its rules, and prior even

to the initiation of the rulemaking process, that Canyon County and its cities would be subject to the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program. The factual basis for this assertion is as follows:

- i. On April 1, 2008, the Idaho governor signed I.C. § 39-116B into law, to be effective July 1, 2008.
- ii. On November 7, 2008, Canyon County received an official letter from the Agency providing notice that the “vehicle fleet” of Canyon County would be required to comply with vehicle emissions testing. See Attachment B.
- iii. On November 18, 2008, eleven (11) days after Canyon County had been notified that it was required to comply with emissions testing, the Agency provided notice of negotiated rulemaking. See Attachment C.
- iv. On April 22, 2009, Canyon County received an official letter from the Agency that reiterated that the vehicle fleet of Canyon County would be required to comply with emissions testing, and requested that Canyon County provide notice whether it intended to enter a Joint Powers Agreement with the Agency, or implement an equivalent motor vehicle emissions control strategy. See Attachment D.
- v. On August 24, 2009, Canyon County proposed an alternative strategy, urged the Agency to revisit its data collection in order to present a solid scientific basis for testing, and described the many air quality initiatives it had already accomplished. See Attachment E.
- vi. On September 24, 2009, Canyon County received an official letter from the Agency that rejected the County’s proposal, citing to the plain language of I.C. § 39-116B as its rationale. The letter further notified the County that the Agency was compelled to move forward with implementation of a motor vehicle emissions testing program in Canyon County. See Attachment F.
- vii. On October 13, 2009, the Agency gave notice of Adoption of Pending rule. See Attachment G.

- viii. On March 29, 2010, the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature adjourned, and the Rule became final and effective.

As of November 7, 2008, the date Canyon County received notice that it would be subject to emissions testing, the Agency was authorized only to have determined (1) whether an airshed within a metropolitan statistical area had ambient concentration design values equal to or above eighty-five percent of a national ambient air quality standard for three consecutive years, and (2) if air pollutants from motor vehicles constituted one of the top two emission sources contributing to that design value. The Agency was not authorized, at that time, to provide which counties or cities within the airshed would be subject to motor vehicle emissions testing.

In fact, Canyon County's proposed alternative program and request that DEQ more thoroughly reflect on the factual and scientific bases of motor vehicle emissions testing was summarily rejected by the Agency before it had even given notice of its adoption of a pending rule.

Section 39-116B, Idaho Code, authorized the Agency to establish which counties or cities would be subject to testing by virtue of the rulemaking process, not simple administrative fiat. By failing to act in accordance with the plain language of I.C. § 39-116B, the Agency acted without reasonable basis in law, failed to comply with procedural requirements promulgated by the legislature to guard against this very sort of administrative abuse, and unlawfully coerced compliance with an apparently discretionary decision.

Furthermore, by sua sponte determining which counties and cities were required to submit to testing prior to the rulemaking process, the Agency failed to comply with the plain language of subsection (3) of I.C. § 39-116B, which requires the Agency to attempt to enter a joint exercise of powers agreement with the board of county commissioners of each county within the airshed in which an emissions testing program is required, as well as the councils of incorporated cities within those counties. Although the Agency determined that the "Treasure Valley airshed" within the Boise City-Nampa metropolitan statistical area met the requirements of I.C. § 39-116B(1), it unlawfully excused a substantial part of that airshed without legislative authorization.

## **2. The Agency is impermissibly exercising legislative authority.**

Article III, Section 1 of the Idaho Constitution vests the legislative power of the state in its senate and house of representatives. Although the legislature may certainly delegate its authority to make findings of fact upon which execution of a statute depends,

it must fix the condition or event on which the statute is to operate itself. *See Boise Redevelopment Agency v. Yick Kong Corp.*, 94 Idaho 876 (1972). It is the duty of the legislature to make policy, and the duty of the agency to implement that policy. In this case, a consequence of the impermissible delegation of lawmaking authority has been DEQ's unregulated use of outdated scientific information.

In addition to vesting the Director of DEQ with an unfettered discretion to define critical terms, I.C. § 39-116B provides no guidance as to the minimal contribution a vehicle emission must make to the design value (only that it be one of the top two emissions sources), or the minimally acceptable emissions reduction the vehicle inspection program, or any proposed alternative, must achieve.

**3. The Agency's implementation of I.C. § 39-116B has rendered the legislation "local" or "special," and hence unconstitutional.**

Article III, Section 19 of the Idaho Constitution provides that the legislature shall not pass local or special laws for limitation of civil or criminal actions, or remitting fines, penalties, or forfeitures. A law is not special when it treats all persons in similar situations alike, and a law is not local when it applies equally to all areas of the state. *Moon v. North Idaho Farmers Ass'n*, 140 Idaho 536 (2004). "A law is not special simply because it may have only a local application or apply only to a special class, if in fact it does apply to all such classes and all similar localities and to all belonging to the specified class to which the law is made applicable." *Moon, citing Bd. Of County Comm'rs of Lemhi County v. Swenson*, 80 Idaho 198 (1958).

Section 39-116B, or the Agency's implementation of that statute, has mandated that persons in Canyon County be treated differently in terms of their privileges and liabilities than persons in, for example, Owyhee or Gem Counties – which are in the same airshed within the same metropolitan statistical area as Canyon County – the same locality and class to which I.C. § 39-116B was intended to apply. As the persons subject to I.C. § 39-116B in similar circumstances and conditions (where such circumstances and conditions in fact trigger application of the law in the first place) are treated differently, either the statute or its execution by the Agency is unconstitutional.

**4. The Agency's implementation of Idaho Code Section 39-116B attaches a new disability to past transactions in the absence of a clear expression of legislative intent that it may do so.**

Pursuant to I.C. § 73-101, Idaho laws are not retroactive unless expressly so declared by the Legislature. Similarly, pursuant to I.C. § 73-106, no right accrued prior to the date a law takes effect may be affected by that law. It is beyond cavil that unless a

contrary intention is clearly indicated, a new statute will not be given retrospective effect. See, e.g., *State ex rel. Wasden v. Daicel Chemical Industries, Ltd.*, 141 Idaho 102 (2005).

In this case, House Bill 586 was approved on April 1, 2008, to become effective as I.C. § 39-116B on July 1, 2008. Nothing in the plain language of the statute suggests that the disability it contemplates – revocation of registration for non-compliance with emissions testing – should or can be applied to past transactions. By its plain language and operative date, I.C. § 39-116B could not apply to any vehicle whose registration was secured or renewed prior, at least, to July 1, 2008. At least six of the Canyon County-owned vehicles for which the Agency has provided notification of impending revocation were most recently registered prior to the effective date of the legislation. See Attachment H, representative of this issue.

Furthermore, while July 1, 2008 is the earliest date the statute could possibly be effective, the testing scheme it contemplates was not functionally effective until the Agency's rulemaking was complete. The relevant IDAPA provisions were not effective until March 29, 2010. Virtually every Canyon County-owned vehicle for which the Agency has provided notification of impending revocation were most recently registered prior to the effective date of the rules. See Attachment I, representative of this issue.

By its interpretation of I.C. § 39-116B, the Agency intends to, or has, unlawfully divest(ed) Canyon County and persons residing in Canyon County of the benefit of registrations fully paid prior to the operative date of the statute or the Agency's own rules.

**5. The Agency's internal procedures regarding notification are subject to critical failure.**


Virtually every "Final Notice" received by Canyon County on or about February 17, 2011 indicates that the original testing date for each vehicle was December 31, 2010. However, the initial notice received for each vehicle clearly indicated that testing was due January 15, 2011. When the second notices were received, indicating that the original test dates were in fact December 31, 2010, the County was unable to reconcile the information received from the Agency. It is unknown how many of the nearly 2000 Canyon County residents threatened with revocation by the Agency in December 2010 were similarly subjected to such confusing and contradictory notice. See Attachments H, I and J, representative of this issue.

Pursuant to IDAPA 58.01.23.044 and .045, notice is hereby given that Canyon County will be represented in this matter by the Canyon County Prosecuting Attorney's office, by and through its Deputy Samuel B. Laugheed. Official documents may be directed to his attention as follows:







RE: HB 586 Vehicle Emissions Testing Control Area Determination

Dear Commissioner Beebe:

House Bill 586, which was passed by the Idaho Legislature in 2008, requires airsheds within a metropolitan statistical area where vehicle emissions are one of the top two emission sources of pollutants, and where the airshed exceeds 85% of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards, to enact vehicle emissions testing or an alternative vehicle emissions control program. The Treasure Valley airshed, which includes all or part of Ada, Canyon, Payette, Gem, Boise, Elmore, and Owyhee counties is subject to HB 586.

Section 2(a) of HB 586 requires that the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) determine "counties and cities within the airshed that will be subject to the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program". To fulfill this requirement DEQ conducted airshed modeling of the vehicle fleets in the counties that make up the airshed to determine the relative contributions of the fleets to the overall air quality problem in the valley.

Based on the results of this modeling, the vehicle fleets of Canyon County and Ada County have been determined to significantly contribute to the overall concentration of ozone in the Treasure Valley airshed, and as such will be required to comply with the provisions of HB 586. Further evaluation showed that vehicle fleets from Payette, Gem, Boise, Elmore and Owyhee counties have minimal impact on overall ozone concentrations. Therefore, vehicle emissions testing or an alternative is not required at this time for these counties. However, please note that if the Treasure Valley airshed is officially designated as a federal nonattainment area the control area determinations (e.g. areas subject to controls such as emissions testing) could be subject to change.



Pursuant to HB 586, DEQ must establish by rule the minimum standards for an inspection and maintenance program. DEQ will begin negotiated rulemaking to fulfill this requirement as soon as possible. A notice of proposed rulemaking will be published in the January Bulletin. The rulemaking process will be open to all interested parties, and you or your designated representative(s) will be invited to participate in the development of these minimum standards through the negotiated rulemaking process.

Once the rulemaking process has been completed, the Director of DEQ will send a written notice to all the affected parties asking for the parties to enter into a joint powers agreement to implement the vehicle inspection and maintenance program, or to present an acceptable alternative vehicle emissions control program that achieves comparable vehicle emissions reductions. If neither of these options is taken by the affected parties, within 120 days of the written notice, DEQ will be required to implement vehicle inspection and maintenance pursuant to the provisions of HB 586.

No action is needed from you at this time. DEQ will be in contact with you or your designated representative in the near future to invite you to participate in negotiated rulemaking. **DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY:** The purpose of this rulemaking is to implement Section 39-116B, Idaho Code, which requires DEQ to enter into rulemaking to establish the minimum requirements for a vehicle emissions testing program when ambient air quality concentrations are at or above 85% of a national ambient air quality standard and motor vehicle emissions constitute one of the two top contributing sources to the concentrations. These minimum requirements will assist affected local entities in determining whether to (1) enter into a joint powers agreement to implement the vehicle emissions testing program or (2) establish an alternative program in lieu of vehicle emissions testing. If local entities do not choose either one of the two options, DEQ must implement the vehicle emissions program.

The text of the rule will be drafted by DEQ in conjunction with a negotiating committee made up of persons having an interest in the development of this rule. Cities, counties, and all citizens in areas required to implement vehicle emissions testing may be interested in participating in this rulemaking. Upon conclusion of negotiations, DEQ intends to publish a proposed rule for public comment in the spring of 2009.

Dear Commissioner Ferdinand:

As you may recall, last fall the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) sent Canyon County a letter that explained House Bill 586, codified at Idaho Code Section 39-116B. (A copy of the letter sent to the City of Boise is enclosed.) In that letter, DEQ notified you that it determined that the vehicle fleets of Canyon and Ada Counties are one of the top two emission sources contributing to ambient concentrations of ozone that exceed 85 percent of the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS).

On January 7, 2009, DEQ published notice of a negotiated rulemaking to establish the minimum standards for an inspection and maintenance program as required in Idaho Code Section 39-116B(2). The rulemaking process is near completion. A copy of the proposed rules is located at [http://www.deq.idaho.gov/rules/air/58\\_0101\\_0901\\_negotiated.cfm](http://www.deq.idaho.gov/rules/air/58_0101_0901_negotiated.cfm). It contains the minimum standards required for an inspection and maintenance program for registered vehicles. Flexibility for implementation of those standards is left to the governing authority.

In accordance with Idaho Code Section 39-116B (3), with this letter, I am requesting that Canyon County notify DEQ whether it intends to enter into a joint exercise of powers agreement with DEQ to implement a vehicle inspection and maintenance program, or whether Canyon County desires instead to implement an alternative motor vehicle emission control strategy that will result in emission reductions equivalent to that of a vehicle inspection program. If Canyon County chooses neither to enter into a joint powers agreement nor to implement an equivalent emission control strategy, or DEQ determines that the proposed alternative motor vehicle emissions control strategy is not equivalent, then DEQ is required, in Idaho Code 39-116B(3), to implement the vehicle inspection and maintenance program for Canyon County. DEQ would then be the governing authority under the proposed rules.

For reference, enclosed is a copy of the current Ada County Automotive and Readjustment Program Joint Powers Agreement language. I provide this only as an example; I am open to suggestions and ideas.

In accordance with Idaho Code Section 39-116B, DEQ must determine that the alternative program will result in an equivalent reduction.

**AUTOMOTIVE INSPECTION AND READJUSTMENT PROGRAM**  
**JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Chapter 23 of Title 67, Idaho Code, provides for certain joint powers and activities between public agencies within the State of Idaho;

WHEREAS, the public agencies signatory to this Agreement desire to create and Air Quality Board and exercise certain joint powers pursuant to said state law for the purpose of implementing and administering a motor vehicle emissions control program;

WHEREAS, enabling legislation known as the 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance has been adopted by each participating agency defining the purpose, nature and scope of such program;

WHEREAS, it is the finding of each public agency that such joint-cooperative effort is the most efficient use of their powers in view of the geographic, economic and other factors influencing such program;

WHEREAS, to be successful, such program within Ada County must function on a uniform basis within the jurisdiction of each public agency;

WHEREAS, each public agency has the authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform individually the functions hereinafter described, and the execution of this Agreement will not extend the jurisdiction, power, privilege or authority of each public agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned public agencies hereby agree to the following terms and conditions of this Agreement.

1. Term. The term of this Agreement shall commence the 1st day of January, 1991, and remain in force until such time that the Automotive Inspection and Repair program provided for in the 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance is terminated.

2. Board Created. There is hereby created an entity to be known as the Air Quality Board, to act on behalf of each public agency signatory to this Agreement, for the purpose herein expressed.

3. Purpose of the Board. The purpose of the Board shall be to implement and administer the Automotive Inspection and Readjustment program as the same is set forth in the 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference and attachment. Duties, responsibilities and guidelines for the Board are also included in Exhibit "A".

4. Board Composition. The Board shall consist of one elected official from each agency signatory to this agreement, and one citizen-at-large appointed by each agency

signatory to this agreement, except that representation for Ada County Highway District shall be limited to either one elected official or one citizen-at-large. One representative of Public Health District IV, or any agency that may succeed to its powers and duties, shall serve as an ex-officio member. The Director shall also serve as an ex-officio member. Each agency shall be responsible for selecting its representative(s) who shall serve until removed or replaced by the appointing agency.

5. By-Laws. The Board shall adopt By-Laws and distribute same to the chief executive officer of each agency signatory to this agreement.

6. Funding. Funding for the program shall be a combination of state or federal grants, matching funds, inspection fees, and any other monies appropriated or accruing to the Air Quality Board. All financial transactions for the program shall be within the Motor Vehicle Emissions Inspection Fund established in Exhibit "A" and shall be accounted for in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Budgetary procedures of the Air Quality Board shall be as specified in Exhibit "A".

7. Termination. The Board shall not be terminated prior to termination of the 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance. The withdrawal of any agency prior to termination shall constitute a forfeiture of any funds or properties contributed by said agency to the Air Quality Board. Upon mutually agreed termination of the 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance by all participating agencies, the remaining funds or property contributed by each participating agency shall be returned to that agency.

8. Agreement to Enforce. The 1991 Motor Vehicle Emissions Control Ordinance, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", provides the statutory enabling law for the implementation and administration of the Automotive Inspection and Readjustment control program. Each public agency, through the execution of this Agreement, agrees to the enforcement of said ordinance, where applicable, within its respective jurisdiction.

9. Miscellaneous. This Agreement and the attached Exhibit "A" shall therefore be executed and adopted by each agency in accordance with all applicable statutory requirements. Any action of the Board shall be subject to compliance with all state and federal laws applicable to municipalities and counties within the State of Idaho.

In order to identify and mitigate the real problem in vehicle emissions, Canyon County would like to submit the following proposal in compliance with Idaho Code 39-116B.

Canyon County proposes implementing a voluntary, one-year pilot program, for vehicles registered in Canyon County, wherein vehicle owners would voluntarily have their vehicles tested at Canyon County new vehicle franchise dealerships which are certified facilities. While the details have not been finalized, the plan includes Canyon County setting aside \$50,000 in our FY10 budget to assist low-income people in repairing their vehicles, if needed. Often, it is the vehicles of the lower-income residents which do not pass, and our goal is to assist them financially to repair their vehicles. Each test would cost \$20, with a portion of the funds paid to the dealer, a portion being returned to the "hardship repair fund," and a portion going into a drawing. Working with the Idaho Lottery, every time a vehicle is tested, the owner's name would go into a drawing for one of several \$5,000 cash cards. At the end of the year, names (the number to be determined by how many vehicles were tested) will be drawn and the winners given the cash card. Commissioners have discussed this plan with the Idaho Lottery, which agreed to operate the program for a \$100 fee.

Once this program is up and running, we will have an accurate idea of what percentage of vehicles registered in Canyon County do not meet emissions standards, and will use this quantifiable data as we revisit the issue and determine whether a permanent vehicle emissions testing program would be beneficial.

There are 182,176 vehicles registered in Canyon County; 11,222 of which are model-year 1980 or before, and 51,608 of which are model year 2003 or newer, leaving 119,346 vehicles falling into the age category for testing. Idaho Department of Transportation is unable to tell us the number of agricultural, hybrid, electric or diesel vehicles, and thus exempt from testing.

Conflicting information makes it difficult for us to know what is factual and what is not. According to information provided by COMPASS, Canyon County's NOx and VOCs can be reduced 252 tons a year, while DEQ is suggesting that the NOx and VOCs from Canyon County vehicles can be reduced by 282 tons. We would like to have the opportunity to run a pilot program and get some scientific numbers before subjecting our residents to a costly program without backup data.

According to the Ada County Highway District, traffic counts on Interstate 84 from Canyon County have decreased in the past year, which we believe will also help the valley's emissions. In addition, Valley Ride's inter-county ridership increased 64.1 percent from FY07 to FY08, and in the nine months of FY09, the Nampa-Caldwell ridership is up "in the teens" according to Valley Ride. This means even more vehicles are off the local highways as people begin to utilize public transportation.

Additionally, we propose instructing local law enforcement to be more aggressive in pulling over and ticketing vehicles which are obviously emitting some sort of pollution. Offenders will receive a traffic ticket, which would later be taken off their record, and the fine rescinded, if they get their car tested and repaired.

We have instituted 4-day work weeks within the county for those employees/departments that have that ability, have no-idling policies for county-owned vehicles, and are in the process of purchasing two hybrid vehicles to add to the county's fleet, replacing two gas vehicles. We have a tool on our county website to aid employees in finding co-workers with whom to carpool, use Pictometry when possible to reduce miles traveled, and offer financial and political support to Valley Regional Transit. We are also cooperating with Treasure Valley Partnership on their public outreach efforts to reduce miles traveled and paint emissions, and have worked with the public to educate them on the issue, and some solutions. We believe public education is a critical component of improving air quality in the Treasure Valley.

While 39-116B addresses vehicle emissions specifically, Canyon County believes there are many other ways we can work to maintain our valley's air quality. We have worked with our local fueling stations to implement Phase I vapor recovery, have enacted ozone-friendly landscape ordinances, and have tied our burning ordinance to the AQI Index, and aggressively enforce the ordinance. Burning ordinances have proven to reduce emissions by 102 tons a year for NOx and 511 tons a year for VOCs.


We have worked with others to educate businesses which use paints and solvents to do so in a manner which is less intrusive to air quality. We also believe that by working with Economic Development to bring businesses into Canyon County, our workforce will have a shorter distance to drive to and from work each day.

It is critical that we take the long view toward improving air quality in the Treasure Valley, and not simply think that industry and vehicles are the only polluters we can control. This is why we feel it's best for Canyon County to take a multi-pronged approach, and accumulate numbers and facts as we go.





Dear Canyon County Commissioners:

Thank you for your letter dated August 24, 2009 written in response to my letter dated April 22, 2009, regarding the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) duties under Idaho Code Section 39-116B, entitled Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance Program.

Per Idaho Code Section 39-116(B)(3) my letter requested that Canyon County notify DEQ within 120 days whether it intends to (1) enter into a joint exercise of powers agreement with DEQ to implement a vehicle inspection and maintenance program, (2) implement an alternative motor vehicle emission control strategy that will result in emission reductions equivalent to that of a vehicle inspection and maintenance program, or (3) have DEQ or its designee implement the vehicle and inspection program for Canyon County residents. Idaho Code Section 39-116B(3) also states that "if the department determines the emissions reductions of the alternative motor vehicle emission control strategy are not equivalent, or no equivalent reductions are proposed, the department or its designee shall implement the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program required pursuant to the provision of this section."

Your letter proposes implementing a voluntary one year pilot program to comply with Idaho Code Section 39-116B. With the information obtained from the proposed voluntary program you assert Canyon County would then "revisit the issue and determine whether a permanent vehicle emissions testing program would be beneficial." You also propose instructing law officers to be more aggressive in pulling over and ticketing vehicles that are obviously emitting pollution, and instituting four day work weeks within the county for employees that have that ability. You note that Canyon County does have a no-idling policy for county-owned vehicles, intends to purchase two hybrid vehicles, encourages carpooling through the use of a county website, and has and will continue to educate the public on ways they can help reduce air pollution.

I commend Canyon County for its efforts to review and implement a wide variety of measures to reduce air pollution. The proposals you suggest and the actions you are currently taking will reduce air pollution in the Treasure Valley. As noted above, however, the law, requires that a proposed alternative must result in emission reductions equivalent to that of a motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program.



Your letter did not quantify the emissions reductions from motor vehicles that you predict would result under your proposal. Therefore, DEQ conducted an evaluation to estimate emission reductions that would occur from your proposal including (1) the implementation of an anti-idling policy, (2) the encouragement of car pooling, (3) the institution of four day work weeks, and (4) replacement of two County vehicles with hybrid vehicles. Using generous assumptions for a reduced work-week, a no-idling policy, alternative transportation participation by county employees, and two hybrid replacements, we estimate that less than 2 tons/year each of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and nitrogen oxides (NOx) reductions would result. These reductions are significantly less than the projected reductions from a vehicle inspection and maintenance program. With regard to the ticketing of "obviously emitting" vehicles, these vehicles do produce excess particulate matter (also a concern) but not necessarily excess VOCs or NOx (the two constituents of concern in producing ozone). Therefore, there is no way to evaluate the expected emission reductions for this specific portion of your proposal. Finally, you indicate that the county will implement a one-year voluntary pilot program to obtain information to determine whether a permanent vehicle emissions testing program would be beneficial. The law does not provide DEQ with the authority to wait and see what emissions reductions may occur after a one year voluntary pilot study.

Therefore, based on our analysis, DEQ has determined that the emissions reductions of the alternative control strategy proposed by Canyon County are not equivalent to the implementation of a motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program. Per Idaho Code Section 39-116B(3) DEQ must move forward with implementing, or designating another entity, to implement the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program. DEQ intends to move forward by issuing a Request for Proposal (RFP) to qualified vendors to solicit, evaluate, and ultimately select the technology and program format that will be used in implementing a motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program in Canyon County. Our goal is to implement a program that will provide measurable reductions in air pollution while also being cost-effective, efficient, and convenient for citizens.

**58.01.01 - RULES FOR THE CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION IN IDAHO**

**DOCKET NO. 58-0101-0901 (FEE RULE)**

**NOTICE OF RULEMAKING - ADOPTION OF PENDING RULE**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This rule has been adopted by the Board of Environmental Quality (Board) and is now pending review by the 2010 Idaho State Legislature for final approval. The pending rule will become final and effective if approved during the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature by concurrent resolution in accordance with Sections 67-5224 and 67-5291, Idaho Code. If the pending rule is approved by concurrent resolution, the rule becomes final and effective upon adoption of the concurrent resolution or upon the date specified in the concurrent resolution.

**AUTHORITY:** In compliance with Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, notice is hereby given that the Board has adopted a pending rule. This action is authorized by Sections 39-105, 39-107, and 39-116B, Idaho Code.

**DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY:** A detailed summary of the reason for adopting the rule is set forth in the initial proposal published in the Idaho Administrative Bulletin, June 3, 2009, Vol. 09-6, pages 105 through 109. The proposed rule has not been revised in response to public comments received; however, the rule has been revised at Sections 518 and 519. The remainder of the rule has been adopted as proposed. After further internal discussion and review, the inspection station and technician license fee requirements set out in Subsections 518.03 and 519.02 have been removed. The financial aspects of running and administering the program will be dealt with as part of the overall procurement process with the selected contractors or subcontractors. Section 39-116B, Idaho Code, only details a motor vehicle registration fee not to exceed \$20 per vehicle. The Rulemaking and Public Comment Summary can be obtained at [http://www.deq.idaho.gov/rules/air/58\\_0101\\_0901\\_pending.cfm](http://www.deq.idaho.gov/rules/air/58_0101_0901_pending.cfm) or by contacting the undersigned.

**FEE SUMMARY:** This rule includes an inspection fee that shall not exceed \$20 per vehicle (Section 524). Imposition of the fee is authorized by Section 39-116B(2)(g), Idaho Code.

**IDAHO CODE SECTION 39-107D STATEMENT:** This rule does not regulate an activity not regulated by the federal government nor is it more stringent than federal regulations. The Clean Air Act requires, in marginal ozone nonattainment areas, a vehicle inspection and maintenance program. This rule is broader in scope than the federal law as it applies to sources in an area not yet designated nonattainment. In addition, promulgation of this rule is required by Section 39-116B, Idaho Code.

This rule constitutes an important preemptive step for the Treasure Valley to take to attempt to avoid an ozone nonattainment designation. The ozone national ambient air quality standard is a standard designed to protect human health and the environment. It is clear under federal law that scientists have determined that a vehicle inspection and maintenance program is an important control measure to implement for ozone reduction.

**518. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSING AUTHORIZED INSPECTION STATIONS OR RETEST STATIONS.**

**01. General.** ( )

**a.** No person or enterprise shall in any manner represent any place as an inspection station or retest station unless such station is operated under a valid license issued by the governing authority. ( )

**b.** No license for any inspection station or retest station may be assigned, transferred or used by other than the original applicant for that specific station. ( )

**02. Applications for License.** Applications for license as an inspection station or retest station shall be made on the forms provided by the governing authority. No license shall be issued unless the governing authority finds that the facilities, tools and equipment of the applicant comply with the requirements set forth in Subsections 518.03 or 518.04. ( )

**03. Requirements for Licensed Inspection Stations.** In order to qualify for issuance and continuance of an inspection station license, an establishment must meet the following requirements: ( )

**a.** Must have a permanent location; ( )

**b.** Must sign a contract pledging the station will not make any emissions related adjustments or repairs on the vehicles it emissions tests; ( )

**c.** Must ensure that at least one employee, who has been issued an emissions technician license by the governing authority, is on duty at all times of station operation; ( )

**d.** Must demonstrate the ability to perform the emissions test and comply with reporting and recordkeeping requirements established by the governing authority; ( )

- e.** Must obtain and maintain in force appropriate business liability insurance; and ( )
- f.** Must have the tools, equipment and supplies, as required by the governing authority, available for performance of the emissions test. ( )
- 04.** Requirements for Licensed Retest Stations. In order to qualify for issuance and continuance of a retest station license, an establishment must meet the requirements listed in Subsection 518.03 with the exception of Subsection 518.03.b. ( )
- 05.** Approval Procedure. ( )
- a.** Applications received by the governing authority will be reviewed for completeness and an inspection of the facility will be performed. An inspection report will be prepared for the governing authority's review. ( )
- b.** Stations which meet the requirements of Subsections 518.01 through 518.04 will be granted an inspection station license or retest station license and issued a station sign. The station sign and license shall be posted in a conspicuous place, readily visible to the public. The station sign and license shall remain the property of the governing authority. ( )
- 06.** Revocation of Inspection Station or Retest Station License. The governing authority has the authority to issue warnings and suspend or revoke a station license upon a showing that emission tests are not being performed in accordance with these rules and any other specifications or procedures enacted by the governing authority. ( )

*(Section 519 is being reprinted in its entirety)*

**519. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSING AUTHORIZED EMISSIONS TECHNICIANS.**

- 01.** Applications for License. Application for a license as an emissions technician shall be filed with the governing authority. Applications for the emissions technician license shall be completed on forms provided by the governing authority. ( )
- 02.** Requirements for Issuance of an Emissions Technician License. An applicant must demonstrate the knowledge and skill necessary to perform an emissions test of motor vehicle engines. The governing authority shall require the minimum standards set forth in 40 CFR 51.367, incorporated by reference into these rules at Section 107. ( )
- 03.** Revocation of Emissions Technician License. The governing authority has the authority to issue warnings and suspend or revoke an emissions technician license upon a showing that emission tests are not being performed in accordance with these rules or any other specifications or procedures enacted by the governing authority. ( )


