Course Description

The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Workshop will provide cities, counties, and solid waste staff with information on:

- The importance of proper disposal of HHW
- Examples of HHW collection programs from around the state
- Funding and other resources available to help communities develop a HHW collection program

Why Is Proper Disposal of HHW Important?

The average household generates more than 20 pounds of HHW per year; however many communities do not have a disposal program in place. Proper HHW disposal will:

- Reduce contamination to public drinking water sources
- Reduce the risk of injury to sanitation workers and firefighters
- Reduce costly emergency response incidents and spill clean ups
- Prevent accidental poisonings



Why Attend?

- Learn about options to develop a HHW collection program in your community.
- **A \$2,000 grant is available** to each county with a representative attending the workshop to help fund a HHW collection event.
- **Five CEUs from the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA) will be provided (pending approval).**
