**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON  
A PERMIT APPLICATION AND PROPOSED PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT**

In compliance with Section 58.01.01.209, Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho, notice is hereby given that the City of Sandpoint has applied to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a permit to construct, P-2011.0134 Project 60949, for the installation of an internal combustion engine that will use biogas produced by the City's wastewater treatment plant to power a combined heat and power system for use at the wastewater treatment plant. The engine and auxiliary equipment will replace an old candlestick flare currently used to flare the biogas. The project should result in an overall decrease in emissions from the plant. The facility, a wastewater treatment plant, is located at 723 S. Ella Ave., Sandpoint. A public comment period on the proposed permit will be provided if a written request is submitted on or before December 5, 2011, and directed to Tessa Stevens, Department of Environmental Quality, 1410 N.
