**To Join a Conference Call**

**1) Auto-Attendant Transfer Option**

Conference Call Auto-Attendant Number:

- Extension 0101: Inside DEQ phone system
- (208) 373-0101: Outside callers

Participants call auto-attendant number and are then prompted to enter their pre-arranged conference call bridge number and in this case press the number **3**. Once the bridge number has been entered, callers are automatically connected to their conference call.

**Notification**

As participants are added to a conference call, an audible chime is heard by participants already connected to the call. If the conference is in progress when the chime is sounded, it is advisable to acknowledge the new participant and ask who has joined the call. This will ensure that the new caller has gained access to the proper call.
