**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON
A PERMIT APPLICATION AND PROPOSED PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT**

In compliance with Section 58.01.01.209, Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho, notice is hereby given that Nonpareil Corporation, Blackfoot, has applied to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a permit to construct, P-2010.0057 Project 61004, to install a new dehydration dryer and air makeup unit; remove conditions for the scratch mash dryer and its pneumatic conveyor and the starch dryer and starch baghouse from its existing permit. The applicant has also requested that DEQ remove the option to burn #6 fuel oil in the west boiler. The facility, a potato processing plant, is located at 40 North 400 West, Blackfoot, Idaho. A public comment period on the proposed permit will be provided if a written request is submitted on or before March 20, 2012, and directed to Tessa Stevens, Department of Environmental Quality, 1410 N.
