### 2012 Beneficial Use Reconnaissance Program (BURP)

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will be hiring **Environmental Technicians** to monitor Idaho's streams to evaluate water quality conditions. Crews are based out of DEQ state and regional offices throughout Idaho and camp in remote locations three or more nights per week. Crews may be required to furnish their own camping and cooking equipment. Crews are provided transportation and monitoring equipment, as well as monitoring and CPR training. Applicants must be available mid-June through August, with some positions working through September.
