1	City of Driggs*	130	IFRO	\$60,000	\$30,000	Facility plan to address contamination violations and low pressure problems.
2	City of Jerome*	87	TFRO	\$90,000	\$45,000	City wants to hydraulically evaluate the system and determine what improvements are necessary to optimize system performance.
3	Meridian Heights Water and Sewer District*	79	BRO	\$16,900	\$8,450	Replace leaking/breaking water mains.
4	Snake River Middle School Drinking Water System*	79	PRO	\$10,000	\$5,000	The project will provide engineering study for treatment of drinking water that has exceeded MCL for nitrates in drinking water. The exceedance presents a high health risk for the children.
5	City of East Hope*	75	CRO	\$20,000	\$10,000	Evaluate options for meeting peak demand, updating the reservoir and replacing waterlines.
6	City of Rogerson*	70	TFRO	\$45,000	\$22,500	System wants to evaluate the need for a new water source, storage capacity and whether distribution amendments are needed.
7	City of Midvale*	65	BRO	\$30,000	\$15,000	Provide redundancy, standby power, elevated storage, and fire flow. Reduce dead-ends and taste/odor/sand problems. Improve booster station and pump selection.
8	City of Sugar City*	64	IFRO	\$50,000	\$25,000	Develop a plan to identify its deficiencies, and needs for improvement.
9	Lacey's Vista Acres Water Corporation*	59	PRO	\$35,000	\$17,500	Facility plan to address source distribution deficiencies.
10	Carlin Bay Property Owners Association*	48	CRO	\$30,000	\$15,000	Address lack of redundancy, back-up power, pump upgrades, metering and treatment needs.
11	Rose Lake Water Association*	47	CRO	\$30,000	\$15,000	Evaluate options for arsenic treatment and water loss through leaking waterlines.
12	City of Rexburg*	34	IFRO	\$70,000	\$35,000	Facility plan to consider acquiring a new well, adding pumps, boosters and water rights.
13	Star Sewer and Water District	26	BRO	\$60,000	\$30,000	Update 2006 FP to reflect significant system changes.
14	Spirit Bend Water Association	10	CRO	\$30,000	\$15,000	System experiences excessive leaking and needs looping in the distribution system (.75 miles of line). Planning effort will explore alternatives.
15	Boise Holcomb	0	BRO	\$0	\$0	No project description or costs provided.
