Mr. Gantz,

Dynamis' plan to identify and divert unacceptable waste from the combustion site is flawed. They rely on landfill employees to divert truckloads of suspicious material away from the facility - a leap of faith in the ability of booth operators to inspect closed trucks, and, they state that Dynamis employees "can" inspect MSW on the tipping floor for banned substances, not "will" sort through the refuse. Unless, and until, Dynamis and Ada County come up with a defined protocol to eliminate toxics, the proposed facility lacks credibility.

Yet another reason to deny the site permit.
