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## **Purpose**

In an effort to begin a diesel emission reduction project successfully, the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (IDEQ) seeks information from interested vendors regarding methods and equipment necessary to effectively complete procurement and installation of Diesel Particulate Filters (DPFs) on stationary diesel generators (GENSETs). The information provided to IDEQ will assist in the development of the Request for Proposal (RFP) for this project.

## **Overview**

IDEQ's Diesel Emission Reduction Program (DERP) utilizes Federal funding primarily from the Diesel Emission Reduction Act (DERA) to complete retrofit projects throughout Idaho. The Diesel Emission Reduction Act was formed as a part of the Energy Policy Act of 2005. This funding promotes clean air strategies by working with manufacturers, fleet operators, air quality professionals, environmental and community organizations, as well as state and local officials to reduce diesel emissions. While current EPA regulations have produced cleaner diesel engines today than ever before, diesel engines can operate for 20 to 30 years, leaving millions of legacy diesel engines still in operation. The DERP's main objective is to target these legacy diesel engines and clean up their emissions using grant funding provided by DERA.

## **Agency Needs**

IDEQ's DERP identified a target fleet of six diesel generators to receive diesel emission reduction technologies. IDEQ has funding approval for the use of Diesel Particulate Filters (DPFs) with either Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) or California Air Resource Board (CARB) verification. IDEQ intends to issue an RFP to identify a successful manufacturer/installation team interested in supporting the following activities:

1. Identify appropriate emission reduction technologies
2. Complete pre-assessment of engines, in conjunction with viable technology
3. Complete successful installation of technologies on qualified diesel engines
4. Provide training to engine owner's personnel
5. Provide technical support following the installation
6. Provide product/service warranties

## **Response Requirements**

IDEQ is looking for an efficient and successful way to complete the procurement and installation of diesel emission reduction technologies. IDEQ intends to use the information collected under this RFI to issue an RFP.

In responding to this RFI, please provide the following:

1. Brief overview of your business and qualifications
2. Brief summary of products and services offered
3. Information on previous projects which have utilized DPF products and services you/your company have completed
4. Assessment on the strengths and weaknesses of retrofit projects; including pitfalls contractors should be aware of with retrofit technologies.

If any vendor believes their responses contain confidential information, please mark those pages accordingly. Cost information and costing models will be used for budgetary or planning purposes only, and can be marked confidential if necessary. DEQ is interested in suggestions and elements necessary to secure the best possible RFP.
