

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

SIERRA NEVADA RD. & MAIN ST. REMEDY PROTECTION PROJECT

Separate sealed BIDS for the Sierra Nevada Rd. & Main St. Remedy Protection Project located in the City of Wardner, Idaho will be received by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (IDEQ) at 1410 North Hilton, Boise, ID 83706 at 4:00 pm local time on February 15, 2013. The BIDS will then be publicly opened and read aloud in the IDEQ lobby at 4:00 pm local time.

The work involves the construction of precast catch basins, a precast concrete sediment basin, approximately 150 lf of storm drain piping, rock armored ditches, paving and gravel roadway surfacing, curb and gutter installation, and other related work as set forth in the Contract Documents. It is the intent of these documents to describe the work required to complete this project in sufficient detail to secure comparable bids. All parts or work not specifically mentioned which are necessary in order to provide a complete installation shall be included in the bid and shall conform to all Local, State and Federal requirements. Bidders are not required to be licensed as a Public Works Contractor in the State of Idaho, however, they must be licensed prior to award of the contract.


Before a contract will be awarded for work contemplated herein, the IDEQ will conduct such investigation as is necessary to determine the performance record and ability of the apparent low bidder to perform the size and type of work specified under this Contract. Upon request, the Bidder shall submit such information as deemed necessary by the IDEQ to evaluate the Bidder's qualifications.

All bids must be signed and accompanied by evidence of authority to sign.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security in the form of a bid bond, certified check, cashier's check or cash in the amount of 5% of the bid proposal. Said bid security shall be forfeited to the IDEQ as liquidated damages should the successful bidder fail to enter into contract in accordance with their proposal as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

IDEQ reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive any nonmaterial irregularities in the bids received, and to accept the proposal deemed most advantageous to the best interest of IDEQ.
