Notice of Receipt: Application for Renewal of the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Permit for the Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. Boise Service Center in Boise, Idaho (EPA ID No. IDD981770498) [Docket #: 10HW-1301

What Is Proposed? The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has received an application to renew the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Permit for the Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. Boise Service Center facility. The application was received on February 14, 2013.

Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. currently has an approved Hazardous Waste Management Act/Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (HWMA/RCRA) Storage Permit for the facility located at 6334 Supply Way, Boise, Idaho 83716-5532, in Ada County. This permit is due to expire on August 14, 2013.



Describe The Facility Subject to Permitting: Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. is an international service-oriented company whose customers are primarily engaged in automotive repair, industrial maintenance and dry cleaning. The company offers solvent collection and reclamation services for its customers, more than 99% of whom generate less than 1000 kilograms (2200 pounds) per month.

The Boise facility operates as a branch service center. The service center operations include distribution of parts washer solvents to customers and collection of spent materials. The waste solvents are returned to the facility and temporarily stored in either the above ground storage tank or within the container storage areas.

The majority of spent materials is reclaimed or recycled and is potentially returned to the customer as useable product. Other spent

materials are managed as hazardous wastes. The spent materials and hazardous wastes are stored at the facility until they are shipped to one of Safety-Kleen's recycle centers, an independent solvent reclaimer, or another permitted treatment or disposal facility.

The facility includes:

- 12,000-gallon storage tank
- 4,464-gallon container storage warehouse
- 2,592-gallon container storage metal shed
- 374-gallon drum washer dumpster

What Are DEQ's Responsibilities?

DEQ is the regulatory agency that helps protect and enhance Idaho's water and air quality, and helps ensure proper management and disposal of hazardous and solid wastes. One way DEQ does this is by requiring permits for certain activities.

What Legal Requirements Apply?

Idaho's rules for administrative procedure require that DEQ provide an owner or operator and the public, through a newspaper notice, the opportunity to submit written comments on the draft storage permit.

What Happens Next? DEQ will review the renewal application for technical completeness and identify any deficiencies, as necessary, to ensure compliance with all applicable regulations. Upon determination that the application is complete, DEQ will draft a permit and allow interested parties to review the draft permit, and submit comments prior to making a final decision on the permit.
