3*	City of Winchester	107	LRO	\$75,000	\$37,500	Facility plan to address water supply, storage and options for adding capacity.
4*	Central Shoshone County Water District	102	CRO	\$65,000	\$32,500	Planning study to evaluate the distribution system.
5*	City of Lava Hot Springs	93	PRO	\$45,000	\$22,500	Facility plan to address distribution system and possible new water source.
6*	East Shoshone County Water District	85	CRO	\$57,900	\$28,950	Facility plan to address excessive water loss, storage solutions and system redundancy.

8*	City of Wendell	69	TFRO	\$70,000	\$35,000	Planning study to evaluate system hydraulics, identify system deficiencies and address compliance goals.
9	City of Heyburn	69	TFRO	\$80,000	\$40,000	Planning study to evaluate system hydraulics, identify system deficiencies and plan for future growth.
10	City of Eagle	69	BRO	\$75,000	\$37,500	Update facility plan, including growth issues, secondary contaminants, stagnation in lines, standby power and linking two independent systems.
11	City of Harrison	68	CRO	\$48,500	\$24,250	Facility plan to evaluate effectiveness of treatment, failing storage tanks and upgrades to the distribution system.
12	City of Hazelton	68	TFRO	\$70,000	\$35,000	Facility plan will address distribution inadequacies, aging service meters, future growth and the lack of standby power.
13	City of Bliss	67	IFRO	\$39,400	\$19,700	Planning study to evaluate system hydraulics, identify system deficiencies and plan for future growth.
14	City of Aberdeen	65	PRO	\$40,000	\$20,000	Evaluation of the current and projected water demands, production and redundant supply to meet compliance.
15	City of Eden	62	TFRO	\$40,000	\$20,000	Facility plan to address growth and distribution inadequacies.

16	City of Hailey	60	TFRO	\$200,000	\$100,000	Planning study to evaluate system hydraulics and plan for future growth.
17	City of Parker	57	IFRO	\$40,000	\$20,000	Facility plan to address an aging system and explore implementing a capital improvement plan/fund.
