North Fork Coeur d'Alene River Temperature Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs)

What: The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will host a public meeting open house to discuss the draft temperature total maximum daily loads (TMDLs) proposed for streams in the Upper (North Fork) Coeur d'Alene River Subbasin. The proposed TMDLs establish solar load reduction goals for streams that are too warm during parts of the year and exceed Idaho water quality standards for temperature.

The TMDLs have been developed through an extensive public process with the multi-stakeholder North Fork Coeur d'Alene River Watershed Advisory Group (WAG). The TMDLs are also now available for public review and comment. This open house will have staff available to answer questions about the TMDLs, water quality management, and project ideas to improve water quality. Public comments will be received through June 10, 2013.
