**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON  
A PERMIT APPLICATION AND PROPOSED PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT**

In compliance with Section 58.01.01.209, Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho, notice is hereby given that the Idaho Power Company, New Plymouth, has applied to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a permit to construct, P-2009.0092 Project 61199, to revise its permit to construct for the Langley Gulch Power Plant. Revisions include increasing the cooling water flow rate to the facility's cooling tower and increasing the allowable maintenance and testing operating hours for the facility's fire pump. The facility, a natural gas-fired peaking power plant, is located at 3806 Highway 30 South, New Plymouth, Idaho. A public comment period on the proposed permit will be provided if a written request is submitted on or before July 11, 2013, and directed to Tessa Stevens, Department of Environmental Quality, 1410 N.
