2.7.2 Additional Application Information Requirement

Applicants proposing systems above a suspected unstable landform are required to provide supplemental information on the subsurface sewage disposal application as required in the “Individual/Subsurface Sewage Disposal Rules” (IDAPA 58.01.03.005.04.o) (section 8.1). The septic tank and drainfield shall not be installed on an unstable landform, where operation of the subsurface sewage disposal system may be adversely affected or where effluent discharged to the subsurface will contribute to the unstable nature of the downslope landform.

A permit shall be denied for a subsurface sewage disposal system application where any portion of the system must be installed on an unstable landform. Locating subsurface sewage disposal systems on unstable landforms will result in adverse system operation, performance, and effluent treatment.
