A draft finding of no significant impact (FONSI) was issued by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on June 3, 2014 for the City of Minidoka drinking water well project, based on a careful review of the environmental information document prepared by Keller Associates.

The draft FONSI was published in the *Weekly Mailer*, newspaper of greatest distribution on June 10, 2014 and the *News Journal*, newspaper of record for the City of Minidoka on June 12, 2014. No comments were received during the 30-day public comment period following publication. Therefore, the record of decision for the City of Minidoka drinking water well project, a FONSI, is final.
