Subject: Wildwood Park Company, Reuse Permit LA-000102-03, Minor Permit
Modification

Dear Ms. Slaughterbeck:

This letter is a notification regarding a modification to the Wildwood Park Company Permit LA-000102-03 issued by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on January 14, 2010. Your permit is currently scheduled to expire on January 14, 2015. This modification, referred to as Modification 1, extends the permit expiration date by one (1) year. With the issuance of this modification, the Wildwood Park Company is permitted to continue operating the wastewater reuse system under the terms and conditions of the current permit until January 14, 2016.

Per IDAPA 58.01.17.700, a modification may be initiated by DEQ in the event of a change to standards or regulations after the permit was issued. In 2011, IDAPA 58.01.17 (Recycled Water Rules) were changed to allow DEQ to issue permits for up to 10 years. Per the Recycled Water Rules, this modification is considered a minor modification; therefore, no public comment period is necessary.

Annual reports and monitoring data from the Wildwood Park Company recycled water system demonstrate substantial compliance with Permit LA-000102-03. Permit LA-000102-03 allows the Wildwood Park Company to irrigate up to 125,000 gallons per year on 1 acre. Hydraulic loading has ranged between 22,500 and 89,000 gallons through the duration of this permit. Permit LA-000102-03 also sets a maximum nitrogen loading limit of 75 lbs/acre-year; annual nitrogen loading has ranged from 11.5 to 54 lbs/acre-year. Allowing the Wildwood Park Company to continue operating the reuse facility in compliance with their permit for an additional year will not pose any increased risk to human health or the environment.

Please note that the dates of the compliance activities listed in the permit will not change. All monitoring and reporting requirements, including submittal to DEQ of an annual site performance report, remain unchanged by this permit modification and applies to the permit extension period.
