On December 13, 2004, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Balanced Rock Sand & Gravel Inc. for a portable rock-crushing facility. Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The DEQ recommends that Balanced Rock Sand & Gravel Inc. maintain this letter, the December 13, 2004 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operations.

Please be aware that Balanced Rock Sand & Gravel Inc. is required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant, or any registered equipment, is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to DEQ 10 days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
