On May 20, 2004, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Hagaman Company Inc. for a portable rock-crushing facility. The registration was determined incomplete June 28, 2004, because registration fees were not paid at the time the registration was submitted. Registration fees were received by DEQ on July 8, 2004. A supplementary registration was submitted November 23, 2004 to correct and verify the equipment serial numbers provided May 20th. The information provided below is a complete and current listing of information registered by Hagaman Company Inc. The information registered is required by IDAPA 58.01.01.797.02 *Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*.


Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The DEQ recommends that Hagaman Company Inc. maintain this letter, the November 9, 2004 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operations.

Please be aware that Hagaman Company Inc. is required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant, or any registered equipment, is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to DEQ ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
