On July 25, 2003, the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Madison County Road Department (Madison County) for a nonmetallic mineral processing plant. Madison County has registered the following information as required by IDAPA 58.01.01.797.02 *Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*.

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Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The Department recommends that Madison County Road Department maintain this letter, their July 25, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operations.

Please be aware that Madison County is required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant, or any registered equipment, is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to the Department ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
