
Please be advised that the registered equipment must comply with the Rules for the Control of Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.790 through 802 (*Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*). Other Air Quality Requirements

If your crushing plant is portable, you will be required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant is moved to a new site of operations. The Department requires that you submit this form 10 days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
