On February 13, 2003, the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received a Permit by Rule (PBR) registration from Tri-C Inc. for a nonmetallic mineral processing plant. Tri-C Inc. has registered the following information as required by IDAPA 58.01.01.797.02 *Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho*.

Owners and operators of nonmetallic mineral processing plants that opt for a PBR shall comply with all of the applicable provisions of IDAPA 58.01.01.795-799. Registration for a PBR does not relieve the owner or operator of portable equipment from the registration and relocation requirements of IDAPA 58.01.01.500. The Department recommends that Tri-C Inc. maintain this letter, their February 13, 2003 PBR registration, and all required monitoring and recordkeeping information at each site of operations.

Tri-C Inc. has paid the registration fee for the PBR as required by IDAPA 58.01.01.800. Tri-C Inc.'s unique processing plant identification number subject to this PBR is Mine ID #10-01665.

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Other Air Quality Requirements

If your crushing plant is portable, you will be required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to DEQ ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
