Dear Mr. Workland:

The Department has reviewed your application for a Permit to Construct for a "Hogged Fuel Boiler" as described in your application dated January 27, 1978 with supplemental information submitted on March 1, April 6, and May 4, 1978.

The Department is satisfied that the proposed facility, as described in the application, is capable of complying with applicable sections of the Rules and Regulations for the control of Air Pollution in Idaho. Therefore, this letter shall serve as a Permit to Construct for the proposed facility. This Permit, however, does not constitute a waiver of your responsibility to comply with all applicable local, state and federal rules and regulations. As provided by Regulation A Section 3, the Department is requiring that performance tests be conducted on the proposed boiler within 60 days after achieving full production rate, but in no case later than 180 days after initial start up. Such tests shall be conducted in accordance with the methods specified in the Department's Procedures Manual (Stack Sampling). Please provide the Department with at least 15 days notice prior to the source test in order that we may have an observer present.
