







CF – Georgetown Canyon Site History

- CF-GTC – Site History
 - Early 1900s ~ Patented Claims aggregated
 - 1955-1965 ~ CF-GTC Fertilizer Facility and Mine Operates
 - Successive Ownership ~ Central Farmers, Agricultural Products, El Paso Chemical, Beker, Nu-West
 - 2001 ~ Plant Site Structure Demolition
 - 2004 ~ Consent Judgment with State of Idaho
 - 2004 to 2008 ~ Site Investigation Completed and Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Developed and Approved
 - 2009 to 2010 ~ Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Implemented
