A draft finding of no significant impact (FONSI) was issued by the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on November 12, 2015 for the City of Plummer's (City's) water system upgrades based on a careful review of the environmental information document prepared by Mountain Waterworks, Inc.

The draft FONSI was published on November 18, 2015 in the *St. Maries Gazette Record*, newspaper of record for the City. No comments were received during the 30-day public comment period following publication. Therefore, the record of decision for the City of Plummer's water system upgrades, a FONSI, is final.
