

Risk Evaluation Manual Software Review

The Department of Environmental Quality is hosting three meetings throughout the State to formally introduce consultants to the Risk Evaluation Manual software. The meetings are for anyone that is involved with the assessment of petroleum releases sites, cleanup of petroleum release sites, or the closure of Underground Storage Tank Sites.

The purpose of the meetings is to provide a basic overview of the software and answer any related questions. In addition as part of the need to use data that is acceptable, DEQ will discuss data quality and validation issues. It is critical that participants download the software and test it before the meeting since we will only be answering questions on its use.
