

**Board Meeting Revisions to Proposed Rule, Docket No. 58-0124-1801
(Adopted by Board on November 14, 2018)**

The revisions made to the proposed rule are highlighted. Only the rule sections containing revisions are included.

300. SITE SPECIFIC RISK EVALUATION REQUIREMENTS.

01. General Requirements. The general requirements for human health risk evaluations shall include, at a minimum: (5-8-09)

a. A conceptual site model which describes contaminant sources; release mechanisms; the magnitude, spatial extent, and temporal trends of petroleum contamination in all affected media; transport routes; current and reasonably likely future land use and human receptors; and relevant exposure scenarios. (5-8-09)

b. Toxicity Information derived from ~~Subsection 800.03 (Table 3)~~ the table of default toxicity values for risk evaluation in the Idaho Risk Evaluation Manual for Petroleum Releases appropriate sources including, but not limited to, those listed in Subsection 300.01.e. (5-8-09)
